At Hilliard Arts Council, our number one priority is always the safety of our guests, staff and volunteers. This concern has been at the heart of our evolving policy decisions regarding COVID over the course of the pandemic. Our policies are informed by the policies and data from a number of reputable sources including national and local health officials, performing arts venues, the local school district and more. As a result we are proud that we have been able to provide arts programming for the community in various ways over the last two years protecting the health of our arts community with minimal disruptions due to COVID infections and spread.

We are aware that things are changing rapidly with the pandemic and there are encouraging signs that our society is moving from a pandemic to an endemic phase. As such, our leadership is re-assessing current safety policies with an eye towards updating them in mid-March. Please stay tuned for more news on that, but in the meantime our policy remains the same:

- Vaccinations are required for participation in HAC programs and activities (boosters recommended for those eligible)
- Proof of vaccination or proof of recent (48 hours) negative COVID test are required for our audiences
- Masks are required when inside the Hilliard Civic and Cultural Arts Center .

We thank you for your support of Hilliard Arts Council and appreciate your patience as we continue to put safety first through these rapidly changing times.
